Due to changes in politics and the advent of Protestantism, religious art took a radical change. Start with a comparison of Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel from its Renaissance style to the new Mannerist School of Art. Mannerism, also known as Late Renaissance, is a style in European art that emerged in the later years of the Italian High Renaissance around 1520 and lasted until about end of the 16th century in Italy, when the Baroque style began to replace it.
